SOUPER BOWL

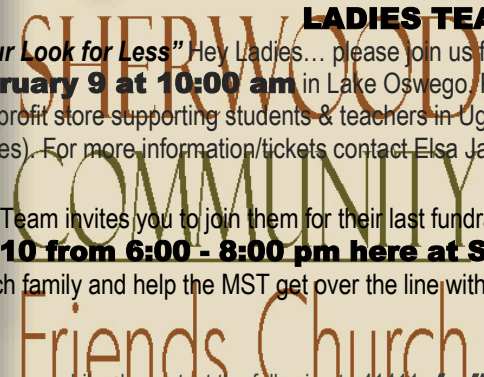
You can help support Willowbrook Food Pantry by bringing in cans of soup or packaged mixes of soup on **Super Bowl Sunday, February 3** when you come to church.

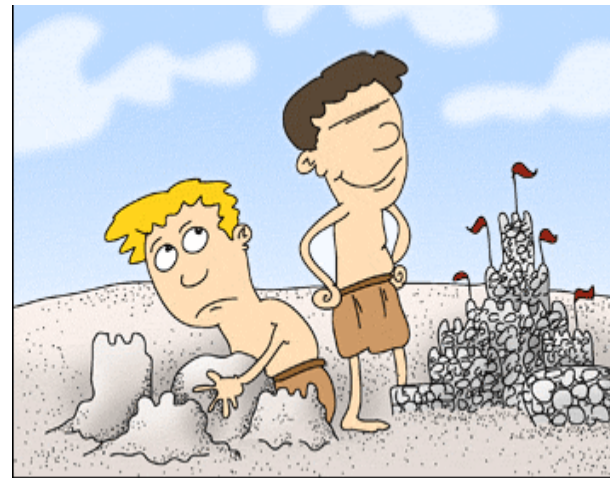
